- Update on the 2016/2017 Eating Disorders Care Teams pilot from Therese Waterhous:
  - o Produced a multipronged training for health care providers about eating disorders, focusing on health care providers with little education about eating disorders.
  - o Formation of a local listsery of providers who have continued their training in the eating disorder field, and more collaboration between providers in Linn, Benton and Lincoln Counties.
  - o The main training modules have received attention from other professionals and groups across the nation.
- Opportunity to present along with IHN-CCO at a virtual Health-Related Services Virtual Convening conference.
  - o Priority topics pertinent to this group include Addressing the statewide housing availability crisis and increasing access to behavioral health services and supports.

#### Pilot Closeout: Community Doula: Melissa Chevney

- See packet for closeout slides. Closeout report will be sent in the follow up email.
- Discussion:
  - o Impact on post-partum depression: saw concerning numbers post COVID-19 lockdown potentially due to lack of parenting groups, increasing isolation, and pandemic behavioral health concerns.
  - o Connect with care coordination teams internal to IHN-CCO to inform Maternity Case Management programs.
  - The doulas that have been trained but not yet certified and registered with the Oregon Health
    Authority (OHA) are able to attend births but cannot get reimbursed from OHA for the three births
    that are required for certification.
  - The length between submitting the paperwork and being certified with OHA is long there are 70 doulas trying to get on the OHA registry.

#### **Minutes**

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- o Equity issues still are apparent; white pregnant people still have better outcomes than the pregnant people of color though all measures are an improvement on national statistics for all groups.
- o Doulas work in all settings including birth centers, homes, and hospitals.
