# SB781: Patient-centered Lab Results/Reporting

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to clinical laboratories; amending ORS 438.430.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. ORS 438.430 is amended to read:

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- 438.430. (1) Except as otherwise provided in ORS 438.010 to 438.510, a clinical laboratory shall examine specimens only at the request of a physician, dentist, or other person authorized by law to
- (2) A person may not report the result of any test, examination, or analysis of a specimen submitted for evidence of human disease except to: (a) The patient or the patient's authorized representative; and
- (b) A physician, dentist, their agents, or other person authorized by law to employ the results [thereof] in the conduct of a practice or in the fulfillment of official duties. 1213 14 15
  - [(3) A clinical laboratory shall provide the results of a test, examination or analysis of a specimen submitted by a patient in writing to the patient:]
    - [(a) Not sooner than seven days after receiving a request for the results from the patient; or]
- [(b) Immediately upon receiving authorization from the doctor, dentist or other person who requested the test, examination or analysis to provide the results to the patient.] 18
- (3) Unless the physician, dentist or other person requesting the laboratory took ination or analysis under subsection (1) of this goating and
