Welcome and Introductions

Transformation Update

- Pilots currently underway- several requests for time only extensions. Nine will be ending and seven will be extending.
- For the RFP 2 pilots, five contracts have been executed. For the RFP 1, these contracts are underway and are working on getting executed.
- Working on hiring an IHN advocate that will help to navigate the IHN space for members.
- Working on navigating interpreter requirements and rules that are being put in place. There are meetings and these are open to comments.
- The 2022 IHN contract should be in hand within the next several days. We can provide an update once we get a look at this contract in the upcoming weeks.

Pilot updates

- CommCard Program
 - Communication tool that can make communication easier for those with developmental disabilities.
 - The program consists of a training session with helping professionals.
 - Each participant gets a wallet sized card that contains information about them, their disability (if they want), their advocate, accommodations.
 - Participants fill out an application for a CommCard and then will receive training on the CommCards.
 - 4 CommCard trainings were able to be done in schools.
 - Challenges:
 - COVID- restrictions around in-person training sessions.
 - How to measure outcomes.

Minutes

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- Culture of Supports
 - Individual centered care.
 - More affordable options for transportation.
 - One goal is to keep members in their homes as they age.
 - Successes:
 - Able to help get a couple of the participants vaccinated.

ENLACES

- Organization created in 2009 to have a culturally based organization that could represent the Latin-X community.
- This is a community health worker program.
 - Would have staff that would help to serve as a bridge for the Latin-X community.
- A video was created this year, containing several community members describing why they choose to get vaccinated.
- Expansion of this program in Linn county has been a success of this pilot.
- Hepatitis C Virus Outreach Screening & Treatment
 - Successes:
 - Interprofessional partnerships and development.
 - Increased readiness.
 - Helped to develop a Hep C library containing resources.
 - Challenges:
 - COVID.
 - Rapid reduction in staff which required prioritization.
 - Identification of gaps in knowledge between partnering organizations.
 - Sustainability:
 - Institutional policies and procedures to ensure that this intervention is sustainable long-term.
- Integrated Foster Child Wellbeing: Not present
- Linn County Crisis Outreach Response
 - Primary population: homeless.
 - Hired a CAN and a half-time employee to help the CAN.
 - Challenges:
 - To get medical professionals on the street to help the most vulnerable population.
 - Able to hand out tents, tarps, and additional supplies to help those without a home during the winter months.
 - Found a HUB space to work out of.
- Mental Health Home Clinic
 - COVID has been a challenge.
 - Decrease ED utilization and increase medication compliance.
 - o Found a location in Lebanon for a stepping off point to continue this program.
 - Hopeful for a Q1 2022 opening.

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- o When COVID is over, there will be a mental health mobile unit that will be operational.
- Navigation to Permanent Supportive Housing
 - Three primary goals
 - o Challenges:
 - COVID halted progress until determining how to work around could be figured out.
 - Devastating fires in the county, which took up time and resources.
 - Requested a time only extension to continue the work. Currently back on track and looking forward to the opportunities to come.
