Considerations

- What information does the CAC need and what information do IHN-CCO members need to get through the redetermination process?
- Does it make sense for the CCO model to be used in the Bridge Plan or should it be the commercial insurance marketplace?



OHP Redeterminations

- Oregon will have 14 months to complete 1.4 million redeterminations after the public health emergency ends (anticipate July).
- Approximately 300,000 CCO members will lose OHP coverage.
- Currently no seamless enrollment between CCO and the subsidized individual market, through the Insurance Marketplace.
- Legislative health policy is to have universal access to health care.
- Legislature passed HB 4035 to create Bridge Plan to help the more at-risk members.



Bridge Program

- CCO members between 139-200% of the federal poverty level, estimate is 55,000. Individual marketplace estimate is 30,000.
- Task Force's second meeting tomorrow and proposal due September 1st.
- CCO based plan with potential to be offered on the exchange.
- Submit Waiver approval to create basic health plan using federal subsidies.
- Target approval date from CMS in Spring 2023.
- Create a permanent plan option with little to no cost for enrollees, plan covers a robust set of benefits.
