

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

Community Partnership Alliance: Carol Davies

- There has been a positive and collaborative response from local agencies. The other agencies have commented about helping with the position being funded and have been very encouraging.
- The proposers have explored Unite Us/Connect Oregon. Service Point was only brought up because it has been so successful already in Eugene. Some agencies are already using this.

Wellness Care Team: Shirley Byrd

- Support from Linn County Health Services through SUD (substance abuse disorder) specialist. Would
 also be hiring a behavioral health specialist. The goal is to engage with a behavioral health provider
 through the school program in Lebanon.
- This would cover Lebanon through outreach. Through the shelter in Sweet Home, other supportive services will be provided.
- The medical school in Lebanon is starting a behavioral health program, hoping to access people from that program that would like to volunteer. Working on recruitment through advertisements.
- There would not be just one person, but a team.

Hope Grows Here: Candace Russo

- Focusing on more of the therapeutic benefits of gardening. The weekly gatherings will be a place to
 also share the disasters of weather or other mishaps. This will allow for a community feel and showing
 that they are not alone.
- There will also be a mobile kitchen will be able to help as well as they will not be able to immediately start a garden that provides for families.
- Transportation is something that is currently being talked about. The community gardens that have been secured already (there are not a lot of plots right now), such as the South Corvallis Garden, will be constructed this fall and there is free public transportation in that area. In Lebanon, although

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transportation will not be provided, the proposer is planning focused outreach. Other outreach will be targeted around other gardens that they will have.

• There is not a time limit on how long after a cancer diagnosis to be eligible.

Improving Access with THWs: Ailiah Schafer and Shawn Collins

- Service navigators were working prior to the pandemic.
- Traditional Health Workers (THWs) will allow the proposer to build a sustainable structure, including more consistent relationships with patients and members.
