Facilitated Discussion Series Proposal

- Three 90-minute sessions focused on systemic racism and racial equity.

 - Centered in engaging with the content and one another, self-reflection, creating dialogue, and mutual learning.

- Ensure discussed during strategic planning next year. Questions include: should equity, improvements in healthcare, and/or transformational be weighted high?, how is the DST

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deciding on proposals on language access and culturally focused services?, should there be an explicit funding cap to proposals?, how to engage Lincoln County organizations more?, should there be an option for partial funding?
