**SHARE Initiative Request for Proposal (RFP)**

- Focus areas are housing supports and medical respite.

**Large Pilot RFP Voting Results**

- Five pilots were approved for funding:
  - End of Life Support
  - Faith Communities Engaging Health
  - Overcoming Obstacles to Dental Care
  - Wellness Care Team
  - Improving Access with THWs
- Seven were denied:
  - Coastal Kids Mentoring Program
  - Workshops on Wellness
  - Homeless Data Harmonization
  - Hope Grows Here
  - Sweet Talk/Conversación Dulce
  - Community Partnership Alliance
  - Easy-A Coach
- Two pilots tied but there are not enough funds to cover both (enough to cover one):
  - Ahead of the Curve
  - THW (Traditional Health Worker) Peer Wellness Doula Collaboration
  - The Regional Planning Council will be the tiebreaker.

**Facilitated Evaluation Discussion**

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The InterCommunity Health Research Institute, IHRI, established in early 2022, is a collaboration to build a robust community partnership that leverages shared resources to evaluate and improve population health and health equity. IHRI, convened by InterCommunity Health Network Coordinated Care Organization (IHN-CCO), includes community partners, key policymakers, researchers, and health care system representatives.

Sandi Phibbs was engaged through IHRI. Sandi is an Oregon State University teacher and is fully trained in evaluation principles with much experience in program evaluation including equity principles and is here to help support the Committee's needs.

### **Dialogue Practice and Helpful Tools:**

- Why evaluate?
  - Helps us see what is working and what is not. Also, evaluation can help to be better serving, as well as to communicate the value of the work. Evaluations may also build collective commitment to a program or cause and gather evidence to support policy change.

### **Participatory and Collaborative Evaluation:**

- Who should be involved, why and how?
- Inclusive of different methods.
- Process of Empowerment.

### **Photovoice Evaluation:**

- Formative, Process and Outcome.
- "SHOWeD" questions: See, Happening, Our lives, Why and Do.
- What do we See here? What is really Happening here? How does this relate to Our lives? Why does this situation, concern or strength exist? And What can we Do about it?

### **Common Evaluation Pitfalls:**

- There is ambivalence about its value or purpose.
- Questions do not align with program needs or are not actionable.
- Marriage to a method.
- Data collection is too complex.
- Evaluation results don't get discussed or disseminated.

### **Evaluation Question Types:**

- Formative:
  - Is the program feasible and appropriate? What adaptations or modifications need to be made?
- Process:
  - Questions include who, what when and where. Were program activities implemented as planned? What worked well? What did not? What can we improve?

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- Outcome:
  - What effect did the program have?
  - Your stakeholders/your community.
  - SMART (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Time-bound) objectives.
  - Other useful models.
