#### Transformation Update

- Supporting Health for All through REinvestment (SHARE) Initiative
  - Focus on housing and medical respite.
  - Received 12 requests for Technical Assistance and templates.
  - Proposals due for those 12 on October 4, 2022.
- Health Equity Workshop
  - The health equity facilitated conversations occurring November, December, & January 2023 at the regularly scheduled meetings should be limited to those that attend the Committee as much as possible.
  - The goal of the training is to provide Committee members with the tools and resources to understand equity in decision-making.

#### Workgroup Updates

#### Connect Oregon – Miranda Miller

- Connect Oregon has moved from a monthly to quarterly cadence.
- Currently Unite Us/Connect Oregon usage is low, the workgroup is working to determine why that is.
- Single sign on will be coming and will help facilitate easier access.
- Working on reconciling users as in who is no longer using Unite Us and who still needs access. Reaching out to Community Partners to see who needs access and training.

#### Health Equity – Beck Fox

- Meeting monthly, recent meeting discussed bringing in presentations and speakers for educational purposes.
- Still seeking a community co-chair.

## Social Determinants of Health – Laurel Schwinabart

• Added an agenda item called Community Spotlight where partners can present programs and work being done in the community. Have had good turnout, participation, and feedback.

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• Seeking a co-chair.

#### Sustainability – Elizabeth Hazlewood

- Recently requested feedback on wants and needs from community partners and restructured.
- Designed a yearly calendar for pilots. This would address basic types of contracting, including what data should be collected and how to report that data.
- Work to discuss outside of the box ideas. How do you diversify funding? What is the plan for when funding ends?

#### Traditional Health Workers (THW) – Andrea Myhre & Renee Smith

- Offering more supervisor training and developing a community of practice. Recognizing that there are multiple pieces, including operational, supervisor level, community need, and practice need.
- For next year, the Workgroup will be working on new pilot welcome and orientation as well as developing a quick reference tool for the IHN-CCO THW Toolkit.

#### Workgroup Strategy Discussion

- Discussion around what topics are missing, are the workgroups working as intended, are there additional goals or workgroups that could be recommended by the Committee?
- Waiver with the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) that allows states to operate differently, in Oregon this is using the CCO model.
- The waiver has been approved, meaning CCOs will continue until at least 2027 barring unforeseen circumstances.
- Some pieces that were approved include additional resources for housing and food. IHN-CCO will bring back more information at the October 27, 2022 meeting. IHN-CCO's Innovator Agent with the Oregon Health Authority also offered to present details on the approval.
- Relating back to the workgroup discussion, the workgroups could align with and support the changes for the upcoming CCO contract year.
  - This could include splitting the SDoH Workgroup into 3 smaller groups to provide recommendations to IHN-CCO on how to fund or resources programs around housing and food. Transportation is also a concern; although IHN-CCO members have access to Non-Emergent Medical Transportation, there are issues with access for emergency needs as well as social needs including grocery shopping, visiting family or friends, and more.
  - The SDoH Workgroup recommendations on housing are still being used and have been operationalized with IHN-CCO. The recommendations have fed the Supporting Health for All through REinvestment (SHARE) Initiative, and other programs and work.
